TREASURER SCHWARTZ DEFENDS MILITARY AND KINDERGARTEN AMENDMENTS
ESA Regulation Hearing Postponed

Carson City, NV – This morning, the Treasurer's office announced a date and time change to the Adoption Hearings for regulations regarding Nevada's Education Savings Account (ESA) program. The hearing was scheduled for Monday, November 23, 2015 at 10:00 AM.

State Treasurer Dan Schwartz said, "Due to our receiving final comments from the Legislative Council Bureau just yesterday afternoon, we will postpone the hearings to a later date. Aside from giving Nevadans more time to review LCB's comments, I disagree with LCB on several points they have made. Rescheduling will provide additional time for LCB to consider our objections. We will shortly announce the revised date and time. Given the importance of the program, we appreciate the public's patience with these last minute changes."

Once a date is set, the updated hearing notice can be found at www.NevadaTreasurer.gov under Education Savings Accounts. A copy of the final proposed regulations are also available on the website. Nevadans wishing to submit comments in writing may do so by emailing them to nevadaschoolchoice@nevadatreasurer.gov.

Nevadans wishing to apply for an ESA during the early enrollment period have until November 30th to get their applications submitted. Applications submitted during early enrollment will be eligible for funding the first week of February, 2016.
