State Treasurer Announces Staffing Changes

Carson City, NV - This morning, State Treasurer Dan Schwartz announced staffing and organizational changes in the office. With the pending launch of Nevada's ESA program, the Treasurer has decided to base the majority of ESA staff in Carson City. This decision has increased the need for senior management in Carson City, leading to the relocation of one of our Senior Deputy Treasurers from Las Vegas to Carson City.

State Treasurer Schwartz said, "For managerial and logistical reasons, we have decided to locate our ESA program in Carson City rather than in Las Vegas. Senior Deputy Treasurer Michael McDonald and I mutually agreed that since his home and family are in Las Vegas, he would prefer to resign. Thus, he has submitted and I have accepted his resignation effective this Friday, October 9".
