ESA APPLICATION ENROLLMENT DEADLINE ON JUNE 30TH

Carson City, NV—The Nevada State Treasurer’s Office announced today that parents have until this Thursday, June 30th to turn in their Education Savings Account applications to the Treasurer’s Office by 5:00 pm in order to be considered for fall funding, should the court rule to lift the injunction. For an application to be considered received it must be received at our office in Carson City (101 N. Carson St., Suite 4) or Las Vegas (555 E. Washington Ave. Suite 4600) by the deadline.

On Friday, June 23, the Nevada Supreme Court announced that they would hear both the *Lopez v. Schwartz* and *Duncan v. Nevada* case on the same day (July 29th) in Las Vegas. The ACLU sought a later date for their hearing with the Supreme Court, but the Court decided it was in the best interest to hear both cases on the same day.

Our office has received over an estimate of 6,000 applications in total. Families that have already applied do not need to reapply. All applications received during the enrollment periods were date stamped, and will be processed promptly if the injunction is lifted. At this time our office cannot provide an estimated timeline to process all of the pending applications, however we are committed to alleviating the backlog as soon as possible.
