## **TREASURER SCHWARTZ ANNOUNCES ANNUAL UNCLAIMED PROPERTY AD**

Las Vegas, NV – Nevada State Treasurer Dan Schwartz announced today that the annual Unclaimed Property ad will be printed on Thursday, August 11th in the *Las Vegas Review Journal*. The ad lists the name of everyone who may have real or personal property reported to the Unclaimed Property division within the last year. This property belongs to Nevadans (or heirs) with a last known address in Clark County and is waiting to be claimed.

“You may discover you are a little richer tomorrow!” said Treasurer Schwartz. “On Thursday, we are running an ad listing unclaimed property in the print version of the *Las Vegas Review Journal*. Tomorrow is your chance to see if the State is holding any money or assets in your name (or a deceased relative’s name). Last week our office ran a similar ad in Northern Nevada, as a result we paid out \$2 million in claims this week. The Unclaimed Property division has gone from 120 days to process a claim, down to same day processing.”

Anyone in Nevada can search their name online on our website at <https://nevadatreasurer.gov/UPSearch/>. Clark County has an estimated \$670 million in unclaimed property.
