UNCLAIMED PROPERTY AUCTION NOW OPEN FOR PREVIEW

Las Vegas, NV – Nevada’s Unclaimed Property Division is opening the vault for a special holiday auction of fine jewelry. It’s a great time to find a treasurer for a special someone.

The auction, held through TNT Auction, will open Monday, November 5 at 9 a.m. PST and closes Wednesday, November 14 at 1 p.m. PST. Items can be previewed online at www.tntauction.com, between now and the auctions opening. The items up for bid come from abandoned safe deposit boxes, the contents of which, after a three-year dormancy period, must be turned over to Nevada’s Unclaimed Property Division. Once delivered, the property is held for a minimum of one year, and a maximum of two years, and is advertised in newspapers around the state prior to being eligible for auction.

“This auction is one that is very special to our office. All of these jewelry items come from a single safe deposit box. The Treasurer’s Office has gone to extensive lengths to attempt to locate the owner or heirs of this incredible collection, but unfortunately were unable to do so. Having a special holiday auction just seemed like a great way to honor these keepsakes,” said Grant Hewitt, Chief of Staff, State Treasurer’s Office.

Once sold, Unclaimed Property continues to hold the value generated from each property for the original owner or their heirs until claimed.
