



Application for Out of State High School Graduates

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS WHO GRADUATED WITH A DIPLOMA FROM AN OUT-OF-STATE HIGH SCHOOL\*

A student who is not a Nevada high school graduate, but whose family or legal guardian is a resident of the State of Nevada must meet all the following requirements to qualify for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship (GGMS).

- 1. Graduate with a diploma from a public or private high school.
2. Complete high school with at least a 3.25 weighted or unweighted grade point average.
3. Pass all areas of the Nevada High School Proficiency Examination if the student graduated from a high school prior to the graduating class of 2017.
4. Receive an enhanced ACT composite score of 21 or higher or a combined reading, math and writing SAT score of 1070 or higher if the student was a member of the graduating class of 2017 or a later graduating class.
5. Establish residency by providing evidence that a parent has been a resident of the State of Nevada for the last two years of the student's high school attendance and verifying financial dependence on the parent or providing evidence that a parent who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, on active duty, and stationed outside Nevada as a result of a permanent change of duty station pursuant to military orders, was a resident of the State of Nevada for the last two years of the student's high school attendance and verifying financial dependence on the parent.

1. Documentation showing student is a dependent on their parent or legal guardians federal tax return for the last 2 years of student’s high school attendance. (If Federal Income Tax Returns were not filed, Verification of Non-filing Letter is required).
2. If parent or legal guardian has not claimed the student as a dependent due to a divorce agreement, etc. a copy of the court filed divorce decree and/or child support stipulation agreement needs to be submitted for review. Any supporting documentation such as out of state tuition invoices will be reviewed.
3. Documentation of residency of parent or legal guardian will be required if tax transcripts were not filed with a Nevada address. (i.e. vehicle registration, lease/mortgage paperwork, or NV issued ID).

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### SECTION IV-Verification

I also understand that required documents must be submitted before I (the student) can be determined to be eligible to receive GGMS scholarship benefits. **DECLARATION OF RESIDENCY  
For Out of State Graduates**

I hereby declare that I have abandoned any domicile or residence in any state or commonwealth of the United States other than the State of Nevada, and I further certify that I or my parents have established a bona fide domicile or residence in the State of Nevada with the intent of making Nevada our true, fixed and permanent home and place of habitation, having clearly abandoned our former domicile or residence and having no intent to make any other location outside the State of Nevada my home and habitation.

I further certify that my parent has been domiciled or a resident in the State of Nevada **for the last two years of my high school attendance** to establish residency per the Board of Regents Handbook, Title 4, Chapter 18, Section 9.3.1(e). Signing a Declaration of Residency is not conclusive proof of residency and supporting documents will be submitted.
