

Application for Students Who Did Not Obtain a High School Diploma from a Public or Private High School (Homeschooled Students)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS WHO DID NOT OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA FROM A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL Homeschooled students must meet all of the following requirements to qualify for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship:

- Would have graduated from high school after May 1, 2000 had the student been enrolled in high school. 1.
- Receive an enhanced ACT composite score of 21 or higher or a combined reading and math SAT score of 990 or higher (if the student took the SAT test before March 2016). If the student took the SAT on or after March 2016, the student needs to obtain a combined reading, math and writing SAT score of 1070 or higher. (Test date should be while the student was enrolled in or would have been enrolled in high school)
- Establish residency by providing evidence that the student or parent has been a resident of the State of Nevada for at least two years of the student's high school attendance.
 - Students who graduated or would have graduated prior to 2017 will also be required to have passed the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam.

(Applications must be submitted within the limitations established in Title 4, Chapter 18, Section 9.1.3 for the student's normal year of high school graduation)
