



Application for Out of State High School Graduates

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS WHO GRADUATED WITH A DIPLOMA FROM AN OUT-OF-STATE HIGH SCHOOL

A student who is not a Nevada high school graduate, but whose family or legal guardian is a resident of the State of Nevada must meet all of the following requirements to qualify for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship.

- 1. Graduate with a diploma from a public or private high school.
2. Complete high school with at least a 3.25 weighted or unweighted grade point average.
3. Pass all areas of the Nevada High School Proficiency Examination if the student graduated from a high school prior to the graduating class of 2017.
4. Receive an enhanced ACT composite score of 21 or higher or a combined reading, math and writing SAT score of 1070 or higher if the student was a member of the graduating class of 2017 or a later graduating class.
5. Establish residency by providing evidence that a parent has been a resident of the State of Nevada for at least two years of the student's high school attendance or providing evidence that a parent who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, on active duty, and stationed outside Nevada as a result of a permanent change of duty station pursuant to military orders, was a resident of the State of Nevada for the last two years of the student's high school attendance and verifying financial dependence on the parent.

- 2) PCS orders (Permanent Change of Station form)
- 3) W-2 for the past 3 years

If you are a graduate of an out-of-state high school you may establish residency by one of the following:

a. Providing evidence that a parent has been a resident of the State of Nevada for the last two years of the student's high school attendance.

Examples of documents that may be submitted are:

1. Vehicle Registration
2. Federal Income Tax Returns
3. Property Tax Form
4. Lease Agreement
5. Driver's License / ID card
6. Voter Registration

b. Verifying financial dependence on the parent who has been a Nevada resident for the last two years of the student's high school attendance. Examples of documents that may be submitted are:

1. Decree of Divorce / Child Support Stipulation
2. Out-of-State Tuition Invoices
