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Israel (as defined in the law), (b) establishing the process for the removal of companies from that list, and (c) otherwise necessary to carry out provisions of sections 24-34 of Senate Bill 26, relating to the limitation of direct and indirect investment by the State Treasurer in those identified companies.

The agency is precluded from action on items raised during Public Comment that are not on the agenda.
