

Eligible Providers Repayment Schedule

Assembly Bill No. 45 (A.B. 45) of the 2023 Legislative Session created the Student Loan Repayment for Providers of Health Care in Underserved Communities Program, which was later renamed the Nevada Health Equity and Loan Assistance (HEAL) Program. Eligible providers of health care who commit to at least 5 years of clinical practice in certain communities in Nevada may receive repayment of student education loans up to \$120,000. The Program's regulations require the State Treasurer to develop and publish the amount of repayment available for the application period for each type of healthcare provider who may be eligible to submit an application to the Program. This is to be published each year on the State Treasurer website at least 30 days prior to the start of the application period. Below is the total amount of funding available and amount for each type of provider for the Calendar Year 2025 application period, which opens January 2025.
