



DECLARATION OF RESIDENCY
For Students Submitted as Non-Resident by Their High School

I hereby declare that I have abandoned any domicile or residence in any state or commonwealth of the United States other than the State of Nevada, and I further certify that I or my parents have established a bona fide domicile or residence in the State of Nevada with the intent of making Nevada our true, fixed and permanent home and place of habitation, having clearly abandoned our former domicile or residence and having no intent to make any other location outside the State of Nevada my home and habitation.

I further certify that I or my parents have been domiciled or a resident in the State of Nevada for at least two years during high school or during the normal years of high school attendance. Signing a Declaration of Residency is not conclusive proof of residency and supporting documents will be submitted.

3. Official transcript from the previous Nevada high school the student attended.
