



DECLARATION OF RESIDENCY

I hereby declare that I have abandoned any domicile or residence in any state or commonwealth of the United States other than the State of Nevada, and I further certify that I or my parents have established a bona fide domicile or residence in the State of Nevada with the intent of making Nevada our true, fixed and permanent home and place of habitation, having clearly abandoned our former domicile or residence and having no intent to make any other location outside the State of Nevada my home and habitation.

I further certify that I or my parents have been domiciled or a resident in the State of Nevada for at least two years during high school or during the normal (4) years of high school attendance. Signing a Declaration of Residency is not conclusive proof of residency and supporting documents will be submitted.

Filing a false Declaration of Residency may result in repayment to the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship Trust Fund and/or loss of eligibility for the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship recipient. Please refer to the Board of Regents Handbook, Title 4, Chapter 18, Section 9 to read the residency guidelines.

Please provide the following supporting documentation to confirm residency and student’s financial dependence on parent or legal guardian residing in Nevada:

1. Documentation showing student is a dependent on their parent or legal guardians federal tax return for prior 2 years. (Must provide last 2 years of filed Federal Income Tax Return Transcripts. If Federal Income Tax Returns were not filed, Verification of Non-filing Letter for prior 2 years is required). These can be ordered on line, by mail, or phone at the following link: <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/tax-return-transcript-types-and-ways-to-order-them> Ordered document originals need to be mailed to the office below, inclusive of the cover letter for the documents.
2. If parent or legal guardian has not claimed the student as a dependent due to a divorce agreement, etc. a copy of the court filed divorce decree needs to be submitted for review.
3. Documentation of residency of parent or legal guardian will be required if tax transcripts were not filed with a Nevada address. (i.e. vehicle registration, lease/mortgage paperwork, or NV issued ID).
4. Official, sealed transcript from the previous Nevada High School the student attended.
