3. The manner in which the State Treasurer will prioritize the award of money available to make repayments of student education loans under the Student Loan Repayment for Providers of Health Care in Underserved Communities Program.
4. The requirements for agreements under which the State Treasurer will make repayments of student education loans under the Student Loan Repayment for Providers of Health Care in Underserved Communities Program.
5. Other matters properly relating the establishment and administration of the Student Loan Repayment for Providers of Health Care in Underserved Communities Program.
